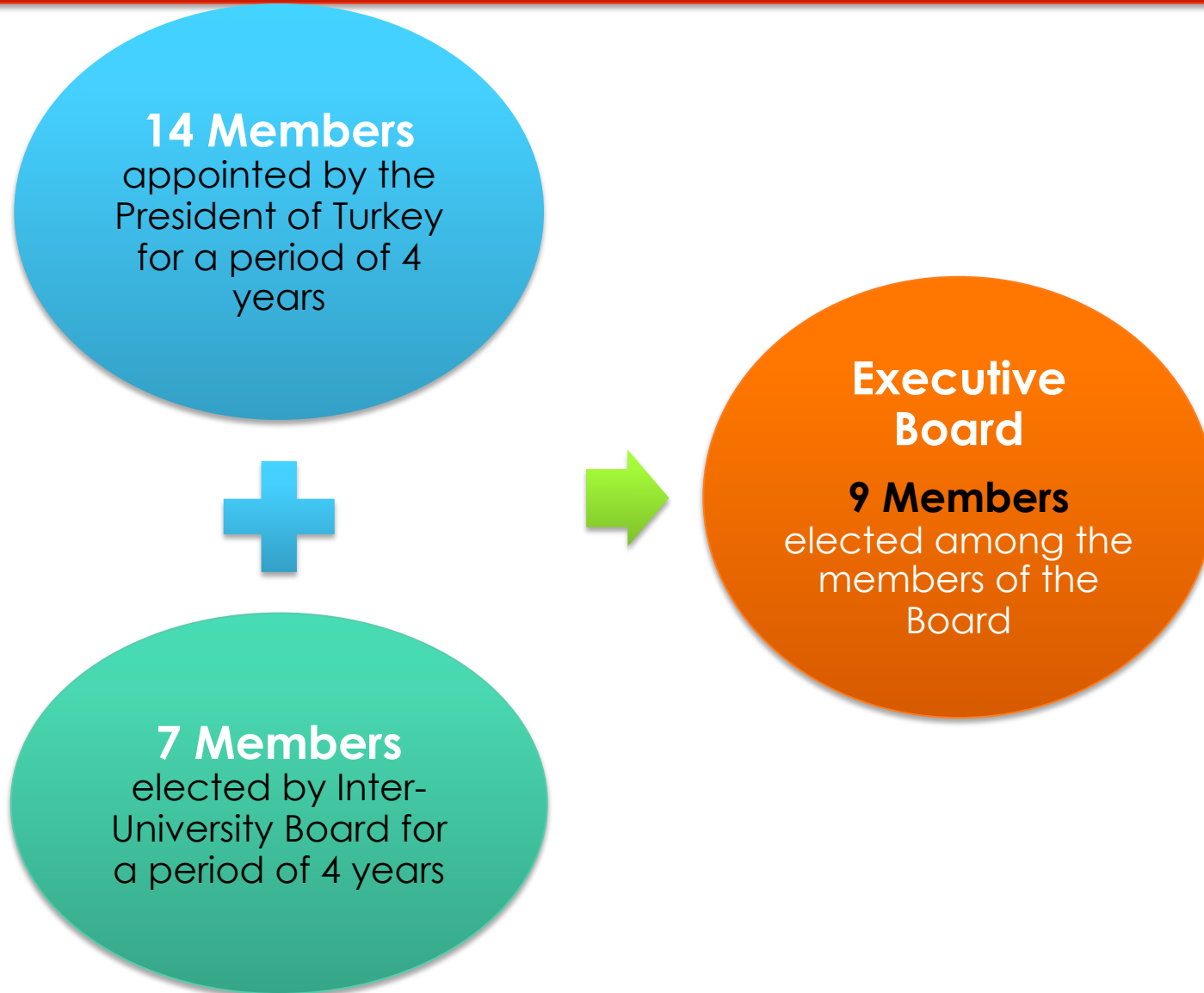
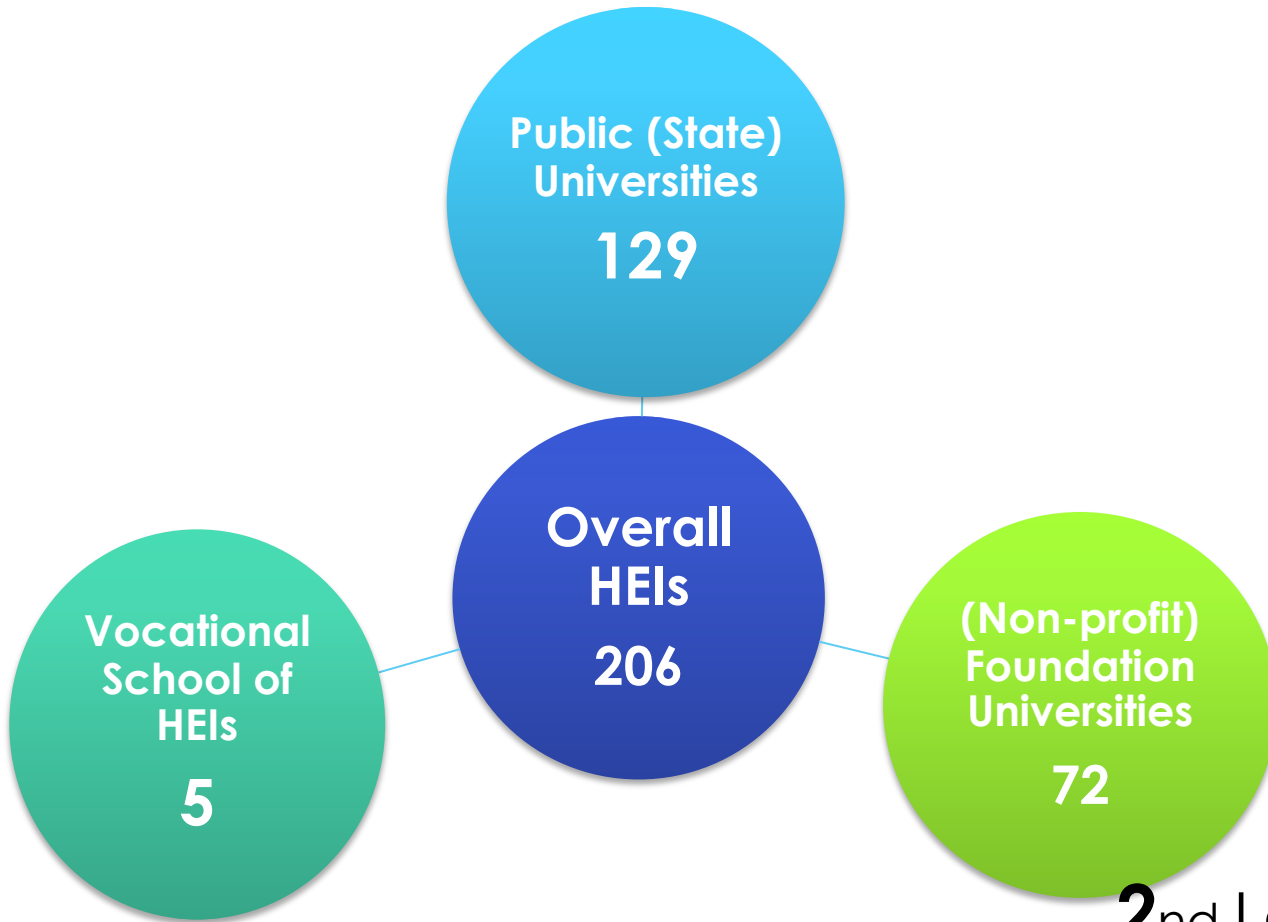

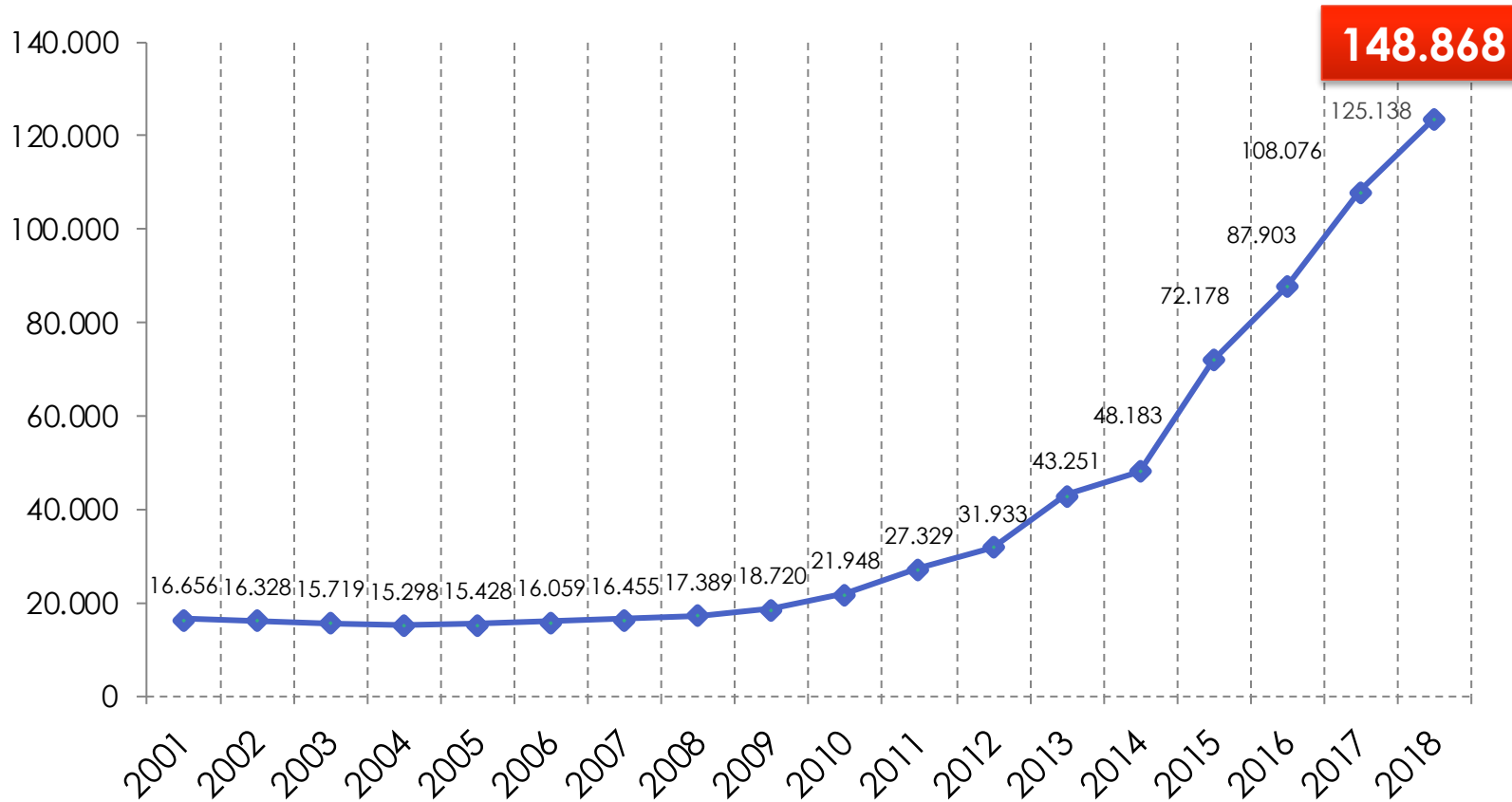

(2001-2018)

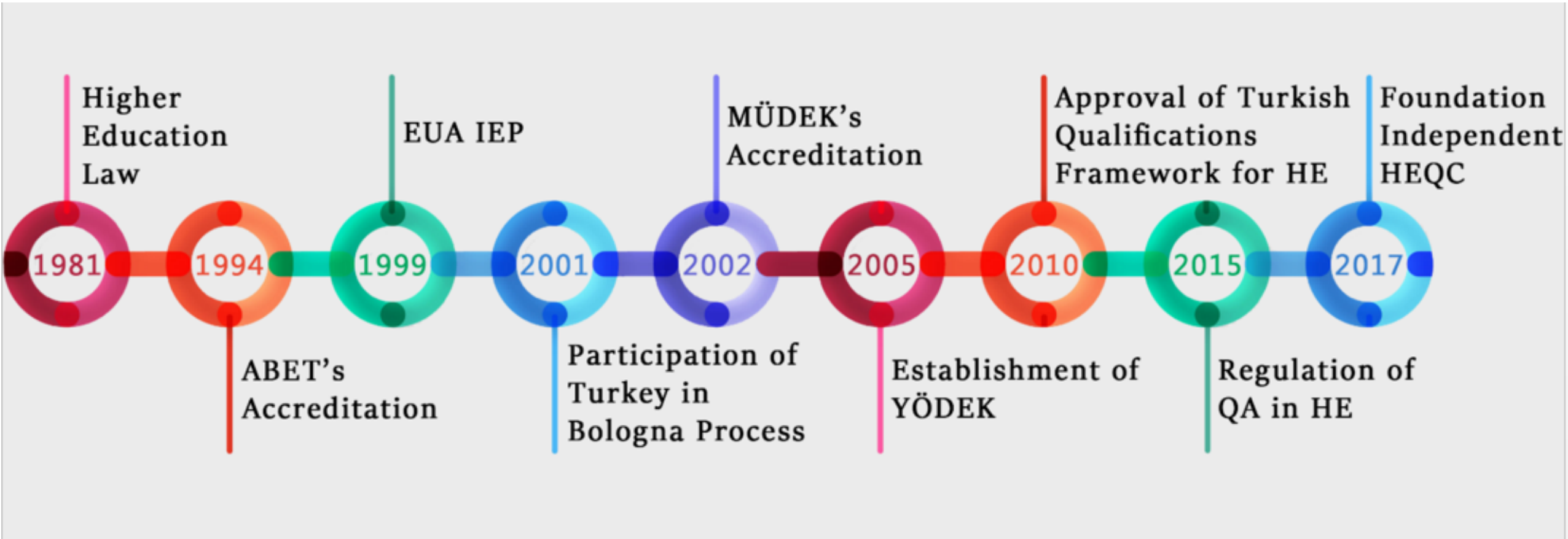
