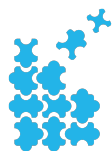
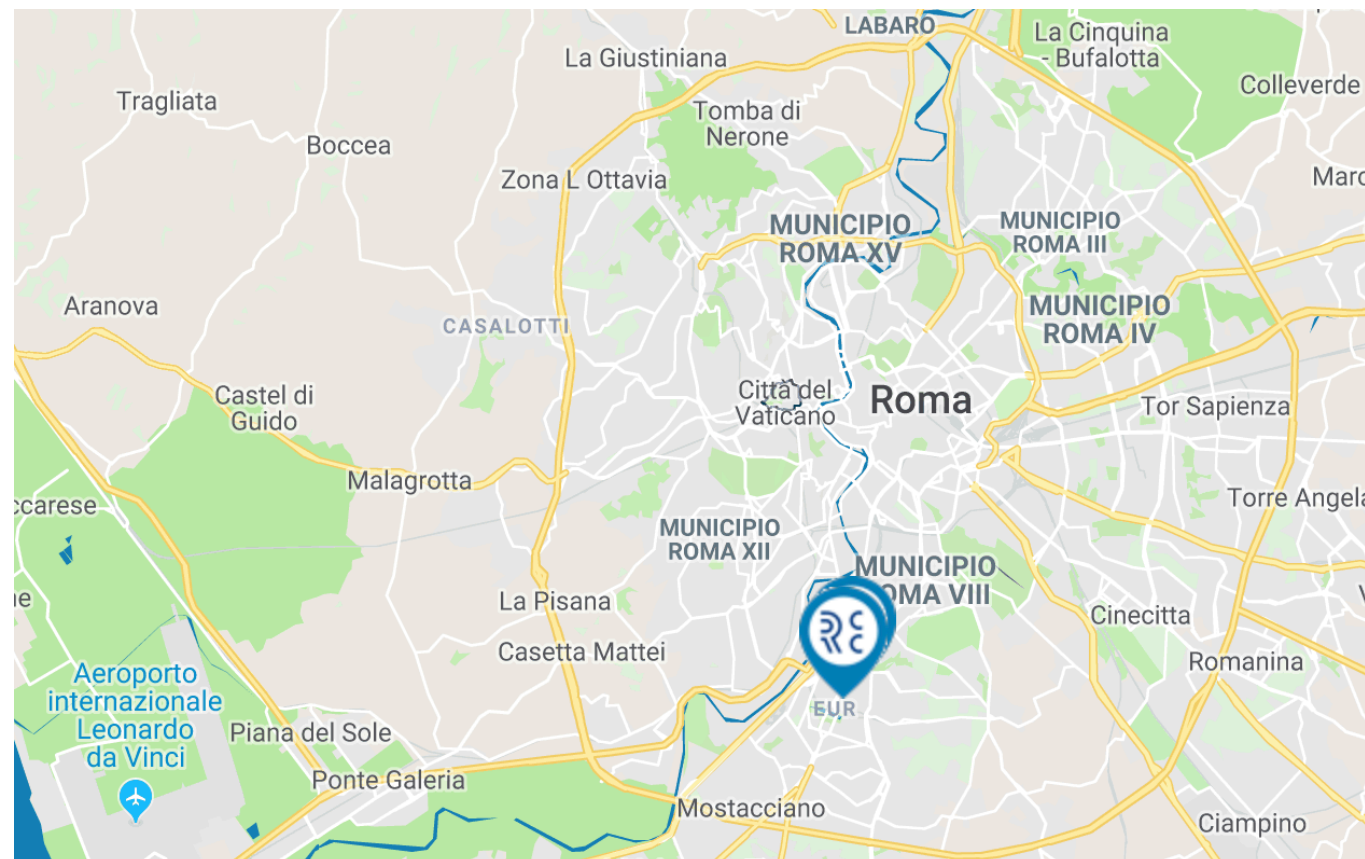

La Nuvola is one of the most iconic buildings in the entire City of Rome.

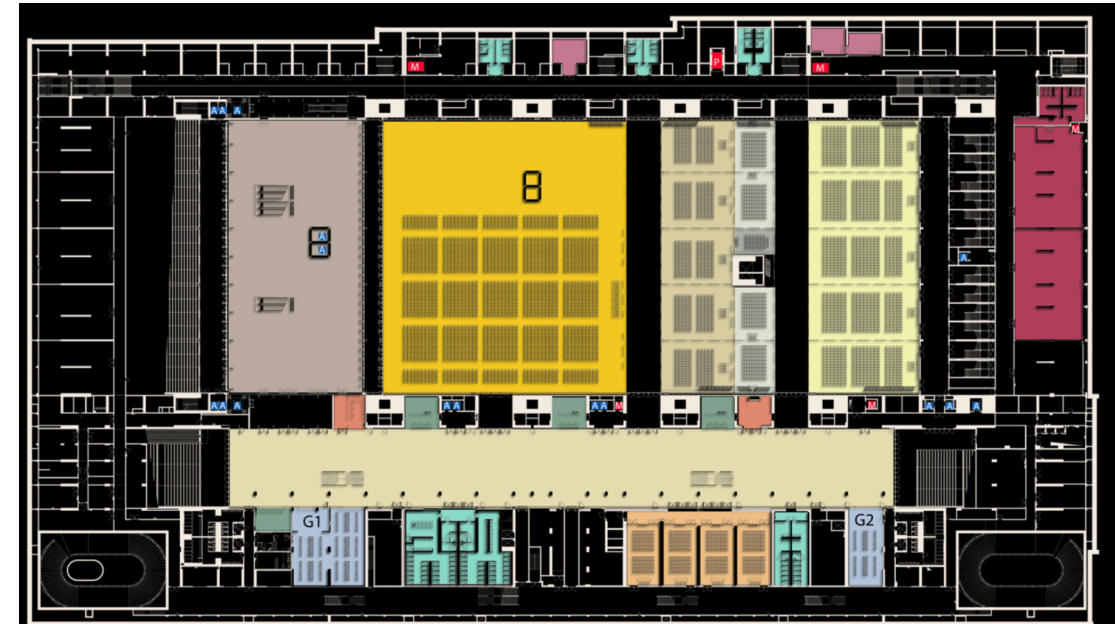
This visionary building by **Massimiliano Fuksas** has been inaugurated on the **29th of October 2016** and since then it has been acknowledged worldwide as a fine example of contemporary aesthetics, characterized by eco-friendly materials and innovative technological solutions.

It presents a floor area of nearly **60,000 sqm** and **8,000 seats**, distributed over three floors:

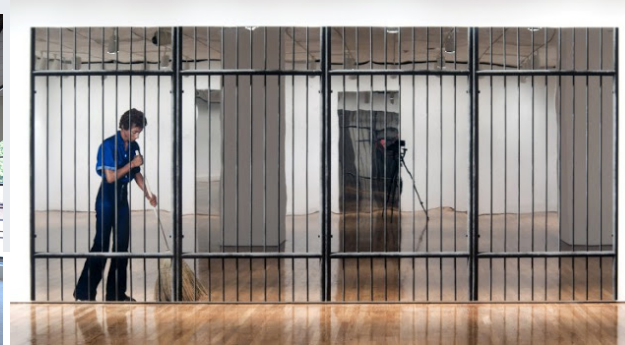
Level Forum: 7,300 sqm dedicated to exhibitions, gala dinners or product display.
